



CALL FOR ABSTRACTS FOR POSTER PRESENTATIONS

NNNG Conference 24th to 25th June 2019

We invite you to submit a poster abstract which presents research, audit or service improvement; in subjects relevant to oral, enteral or parenteral nutrition.

Entry criteria - Open to both NNNG and Non-NNNG members (excludes NNNG committee members).

Abstracts - All will be shortlisted by the NNNG Committee using a set review criteria. Up to ten abstracts deemed the strongest according to the criteria will be awarded a complimentary 2 day place at conference for the first author of the abstract. Accommodation and travel are not included. Reviewing criteria include demonstration of:

- Clear and precise title, background and objectives
- Rationale for the piece of work
- Clear and concise description of work undertaken
- Presentation of results
- Discussion indicating implications and relevance to practice

At the conference you will be expected to stand by your poster at an agreed time to present your findings (maximum 2 minute oral presentation and 3 minutes for questions). Times must be adhered to and marks may be deducted for over running.

Prizes - will be awarded following judging against criteria, up to 3 prizes will be awarded as follows:

- 1st Prize £100 book voucher, free place at conference 2020 , certificate of achievement
- 2nd Prize £75 book voucher, certificate of achievement
- 3rd Prize £50 book voucher, certificate of achievement

- Size A0
- Portrait orientation
- Author/s details (name, title, place of work)
- You are advised to structure the poster using clear sub-headings
- Abbreviations should be defined
- Potential conflicts of interest should be declared
